## Notice No. 18./2021 Of the Deputy Rector for Student Affairs and Education Medical University of Warsaw of 29 October 2021

on the procedure in case of COVID-19 disease symptoms or contact with a person infected with SARS-CoV-2 virus

The following recommendations are developed on the basis of the regulations and information materials of the Chief Sanitary Inspectorate on the coronavirus and recommendations of the University Board for Coronavirus Risk.

- 1. In the event of the appearance of symptoms suggesting SARS-CoV-2 infection (e.g. cough, difficulty breathing, fever, loss of taste and smell), students:
- a. do not come to classes,
- b. immediately inform the teacher and / or the dean's office by e-mail about the absence,
- c. contact their GP and follow their instructions.
- 2. In the case of undergoing quarantine or isolation, and immediately after obtaining a positive result of the test for SARS-CoV-2 virus infection, the student notifies the University by sending the application to the address <a href="mailto:zgloszenia@wum.edu.pl">zgloszenia@wum.edu.pl</a> and follow the instructions of the sanitary and epidemiological station (SANEPID) or the doctor.
- 3. Persons from the so-called "Close contact" \* with a person confirmed to be infected with the SARS-CoV-2 virus may be quarantined and then:
- a. do not come to classes,
- b. immediately inform the teacher of the absence by e-mail,
- c. contact the GP and follow instructions.
- 4. Vaccinated persons (complete vaccination schedule against COVID-19, > 14 days have passed since the completion of the vaccination schedule) and persons who completed isolation or hospitalization due to SARS-CoV-2 virus infection may not be subject to the procedure described in par. 3.
- \* "Close contact" is a contact with a person infected with the SARS-CoV-2 virus, lasting> 15 minutes, at a distance of <1.5 meters, without personal protective equipment.

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
